

4628 Choc-a-Hostess Tray

Have the customer choose four packaged Kilwin's products appropriate for the gift. The customer may want you to make the choices. Try to have at least one package with color (i.e. Berryblues, pastel cherries, Holland Mints, etc.).

1. Gather your ingredients for the container.
2. Remove the price tags.
3. Seal anything that needs to be sealed in a bag.
4. Crumple a piece of tissue in the bottom of the tray. With ¼ stickie, secure first three packages to the tissue starting at the left side. Leave a gap – then secure the last package.
5. If you feel it is necessary, crumple part of a piece of matching tissue between the third and fourth packages.
6. Shrink-wrap the entire tray. Wrap ribbon around the tray and secure at product gap. Secure with a nice bow and add a pick (optional).
